ORDER

On July 25, 2008, counsel for the parties appeared before the court and presented argument on Plaintiff's Motion to Seal Portions of Defendant's Opposition to Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction (Docket No. 56). For the reasons stated from the bench, the Motion to Seal Portions of Defendant's Opposition to Plaintiff's Motion for Preliminary Injunction is taken under advisement. Furthermore, for the reasons stated from the bench, it is hereby

ORDERED that counsel for the parties shall, in accordance with the Order entered on July 3, 2008, have a good faith consultation concerning which pleadings that were filed under seal prior to July 3, 2008, they agree may be unsealed and they shall file a joint report with the Court by Friday, August 1, 2008, identifying the docket entries that may be unsealed. If either party believes that a docket entry, or any portion thereof, filed before July 3, 2008, should remain under seal, it must file a motion requesting that the pleading, or a portion of that pleading, remain under seal along with a memorandum in compliance with Local Civil Rule 5(C) by Friday, August 8, 2008. Any opposition to a motion to maintain a document under seal, must be filed by August 15, 2008. The court will hear argument on any such motion on Friday, August 29, 2008,
