

VICTIM IMPACT STATEMENT

*UNITED STATES V. BP Products North America, Inc.
CASE N. 4:07:CR00434*

On February 4, 2008, BP Products North America Inc ("BP Products") will plead guilty and be sentenced regarding incidents arising from the catastrophic explosion at the Texas City Refinery occurring on March 23, 2005. Under the signed plea agreement, which is subject to court approval, BP Products will admit that it knowingly failed to design and implement procedures to ensure the mechanical integrity of equipment in the Isomerzation Unit, including the Raffinate Splitter, F-20 Blowdown Stack, Relief Valve and Vent Systems, and Critical Alarms, and that these failures led to the explosion on march 23, 2005. BP Products will further admit that it knowingly failed to warn contractor employees of the dangers associated with placing temporary trailers in the vicinity of blowdown stacks.

You have been identified and your contact information was forwarded to the United States Attorney's Office as potential victim in this case. Any victim of a crime has certain rights under federal law including the right to be notified of the convictions of the defendants and the right to be reasonably heard at the sentencing of the defendants. *18 U.S.C. §3771 (a) and (b).*

The United States Department of Justice is obligated to use best efforts to locate and notify the victims of this crime and to inform them of their rights *18 U.S.C. §3771 (c). If you believe you are a victim of the actions of BP Products resulting in the March 23, 2005 explosion, please respond to the question below and return this form to the address provided.*



1. *If you believe you have been affected by this crime, please explain how the criminal conduct of the defendant described above has affected you.*

I am the mother of Susan Taylor, who was killed by the explosion at the BP Texas City Refinery on March 23, 2005. She was working in the J.E. Merit trailer near the ISOM unit of the BP Texas City Refinery when the explosion happened.

I have asked that one of my attorneys, either David Perry or René Haas, of the law firm of Perry & Haas, be allowed to speak in court on my behalf. I want to object to the plea bargain which will be presented to the court, and want my attorney to be able to present, on my behalf, legal reasons why the punishment being suggested is inadequate and should be rejected by the Court.

I would like to be able to tell all of you the impact of what happened on March 23rd, 2005. I wanted someone to look in the eyes so I could ask them why they killed my baby. I haven't been able to do that yet so what I see is everything BP does to show the TV viewing audience what good Community supporters they are. Only I know different. What I feel every day of my life is the most devastating loss a Mother can feel. The pain is so deep and widespread in my family that there really isn't a good word for it.

When you hear of someone being tortured beyond anything I've ever seen or experienced in my life how do you feel? I don't know how anyone can feel there isn't anyone accountable for what has happened and letting them get away with Murder. I don't know how high the penalties can be for what you've done. What you've done and allowed to happen deserves justice.

To know that I feel the way I do toward you as human beings goes against every thing I've ever believed in. I've never wished for any one to die, but the fate I would feel toward the people who killed my daughter, my baby is not even close to what I feel every day of my life. You willfully took her away from me. You have ruined my life because of what you have done, and what you didn't do. I don't even know who all killed her. There are more involved in her murder than just you here today who should be punished. Your fate is nothing compared to mine and my families. How can you live with yourself when I can't even know how to go on with out my baby? Do you have children, maybe you do and maybe you don't. But if you did, you would understand that I pray every minute of every day that every one will pay from the top of the company to the person who pushed the wrong button, for what you have done. Not only to my family and me, but also for the other families that have lost their children or their parents or their sister or their brother or their wife or their husband there has to be a fate worse than what has happened to us but I can't even imagine it. How could you face something worse than what you have done to My Family and me? In my heart I'd love to know that everyone that had a hand in my daughters murder would be punished. Not only monetarily but physically and emotionally and brought to justice so they can't do what they did to my family and me ever again. My Daughter is worth more and her life was worth more that what you've been able to get away with since the murder. God Willing you won't do it again to one of my other children who also work in refineries. Are they safe from people like YOU!

They murdered my daughter and I will never be the same. In my heart she is, but in my arms and her kisses are gone forever. There isn't a day I don't miss her. She was my baby and I've lost her because of you!

You have hurt everyone in our family, it has affected my children's work, our family at every turn, we feel you by your negligence have done the most vicious thing to us.

You took a part of all of us when she was killed. The women and men of our family will always question why you did such a horrible thing to us?
