The United States Attorney charges:

COUNT ONE

On fifteen occasions between January 2001 and October 2002, in the District of Connecticut, OPERATIONS MANAGEMENT INTERNATIONAL, INC., the defendant herein, negligently violated and caused to be violated conditions and limitations implementing Title 33 U.S.C. § 1318 in a discharge permit issued by the State of Connecticut pursuant to Title 33 U.S.C. § 1342, in that the defendant failed to submit all required Total Chlorine Residual monitoring results.

All in violation of Title 33, United States Code, Section 1319(c)(1)(A).
